  - a. New Fire Truck:
    - o Chief Gernaat expressed overall satisfaction with the new truck.
    - o There were a few minor items, but they have all been remedied.

    - o The following items still need to take place:
      - Waiting on fittings
      - Hoses have been shipped
      - Training and Driving instruction
    - o The new pumper-tanker should be in service within the next few weeks.

  - Fuel is running a bit high
  - Vehicle Repairs appear high for the following reason:
    - All the DOT inspections have already been done.
- c. Personnel:
  - o Discussion on current pay rates and potential changes
    - Increase the training wage
    - Go to a single wage
    - Funds from Cares Act
  - Station Personnel
    - Station 1, Tyler Street, staff is currently full
    - Station 2, Borculo, could use four more fire fighters
      - Difficulties finding volunteers for the following reasons:
        - ✓ The proximity to Olive Township Fire Department
        - ✓ Volunteering, overall, is down with the current generation compared to generations of the past.

## d. Millage Renewal Discussion:

- o Current Millage is expiring
- o Discussion on items needed
  - A new fire truck will be needed for Station 2 within the next 5 years.
    - Will need to be ordered within 3 years
- Newsletter
  - Is the time and money worth sending a newsletter out for the millage.
  - Township is looking at avenues of mass distribution for less cost than US Mail.
  - Discussed again in the future
- Motion to recommend to the township board the renewal of the fire department millage of 1.8 mils for 8 years to be placed on the ballot with the school elections was made by Glenn Overweg, support by Dave Postma.
